**Job Purpose:** The Rewinder/Packer is a critical part of the manufacturing finishing process. Key responsibilities include operating equipment to quality check, and finish rolls of labels, securely and properly packing product, and conducting incremental relevant tasks associated with excellence in the finishing process.

#### Candidate Traits

**Reliable:** Candidate must commit to assigned schedule, be punctual, and show up when scheduled for work. Candidate must operate in a safe manner, and keep her or his work space is a safe working environment at all times.

**Quick Learner:** Candidate have ability to adapt quickly to operating equipment, and must be able to quickly understand expectations of deliverables. Training will be provided.

**Agility:** Candidate must be quick on her/his feet, and able to complete and switch tasks quickly and efficiently, while producing excellent work product. In addition, this position is 80+% active standing work, so candidate must meet the physical requirements listed in this description (below).

**Quality Driven:** Candidate must take pride in her or his work, and be meticulous in ensuring only top quality product is packed and shipped for customer delivery.

**Proactive:** Candidate must be willing to help ensure Steinhauser stays at the highest standard with their customers, and if he or she sees an opportunity to improve, must be willing to identify and help make changes necessary to continue operational excellence.

#### Duties *(Include but are not limited to)*

- Work area, machine and material prep, as necessary
- Maintain quality of finished products
- Ensure safe and clean work environment
- Manage parameters outlined regarding material allocations for each job
- Work from job jackets to set up finishing jobs; establishes standards (if new job); double checks for accuracy; checks labels to standards; makes sure rewind is positioned correctly; properly identifies rolls before converting
- Strictly adheres to all QCA procedures
- Brings any production issues to Supervisor's attention immediately
- Complete all necessary finishing paperwork, including but not limited to line clearance documentation, customer specific paperwork, and confirms press pulls are delivered to prep department
- Preventative machine maintenance as needed
- Option (and encouraged) to train in other areas of production to be a back-up option for peers, as needed

**Physical Requirements** (*Must be able to perform the essential functions of this position with or without reasonable accommodations.*)

- Standing: Remaining on one's feet in an upright position without moving about - frequently
- Walking: Moving about on foot - frequently
- Sitting: Remaining in the seated position - seldom
- Lifting/Carrying: Raising/lowering an object from one level to another up to 40 lbs - frequently
- Pushing/Pulling: Exerting force upon an object moves away or toward the force - frequently
- Reaching: Extending hand(s) and arm(s) in any direction - sometimes
- Talking: Expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word or impart oral information to clients - frequently
- Hearing: Perceiving the nature of sounds by ear – frequently
- Vision: Clarity of vision from 20 inches to 20 feet or more – frequently
- Environmental Conditions: Work is performed indoors
- Work Related Tools: Being able to fully utilize hand and power tools -frequently
- Stamina requirements – may be required to work weekend and holidays, up to 50 hours per week - sometimes

**Preferred Qualifications and Skills**

A minimum requirement of high school diploma or general education degree (GED); a technical related degree, certification, or equivalent experience preferred. Possess a TEAMWORK attitude. Successfully handles priorities based on managerial direction. Skilled in internal manufacturing communication. Label manufacturing labor experience and/or knowledge of operating various label equipment is a plus.
