Job Purpose: During this exciting growth, we are looking for a self-motivated candidate to fill this important role and work alongside our Pressman when creating our quality labels for our customer's brands.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for gathering materials needed for next job according to prescribed set up in job folder; locating proper stock as dictated by Bill of Materials; plates are mounted on correct cylinders & gears; inks are color correct, and quantity is available to cover entire length of run.
- Responsible for maintaining proper levels of all necessary chemicals and consumable materials at press side.
 This includes making certain that following shift has sufficient starting quantities of these materials and supplies.
- Ensure all necessary material and supplies are kept at proper stocking levels, including but not limited to plate mounting tape, splicing tape, gloves, wipes, doctor blades and all forms/ID labels.
- Maintain and ensure the press area is a clean and safe working environment, and all necessary precautions are taken throughout a shift.
- Assist in job changeovers by assisting Press Operator with inks, anilox changes, pan cleaning, doctor blade changes. Return all inks and plates to proper storage location upon completion of a job.
- End each shift with a thorough cleaning and walk through the press area & compactor room. Empty trash and dirty rag containers as needed. Keep flexo press area, including roll and skid storage areas, organized, clean and swept.
- Performs any other duties, including work in any other area of the company, as directed by supervisor or any member of the management team.
- When the press is running and the next job is ready, helpers should cut cores, maintain ink dispenser and ink area, unload trucks.

Physical Requirements: Must be able to perform the essential functions of this position with or without reasonable accommodations.

- 1.) Standing: Remaining on one's feet in an upright position without moving about frequently
- 2.) Walking: Moving about on foot frequently
- 3.) Sitting: Remaining in the seated position seldom
- 4.) Lifting/Carrying: Raising/lowering an object from one level to another up to 40 lbs frequently
